Town of Plymouth, CT:

Effective **IMMEDIATELY**, The Town of Plymouth and the Plymouth Fire Marshal's Office have issued a **TEMPORARY BAN** on all outdoor burning in Plymouth. This includes all businesses, town owned property, residential properties, or any other property within the Town of Plymouth.

- All previously issued burn permits are invalid based on the current conditions.
- **ANY** open burning (backyard fires, campfires, cooking fires, warming fires chimineas, recreational/religious, burn barrels, yard debris, charcoal grills etc.) is banned. No open flames.

The Terryville Fire Department will respond to any reported fire and if not extinguished by the owner or occupant, it will be extinguished by FD personnel.

This guidance has been issued by the State of Connecticut, Department of Energy and Environmental Protection (DEEP) and has banned these activities in all State Parks and other land overseen by the State of CT.

The Forest Fire Danger Level remains **EXTREME**.

No burning will take place if the CT DEEP fire danger level remains **HIGH, VERY HIGH, EXTREME** or during **RED FLAG WARNINGS**.
